

# Fuel price report (April 2018)

Unleaded prices have gone up 1.7p from 119.7 ppl to 121.4 ppl. Diesel prices have increased by 1.6p from 122.6 ppl to 124.2 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 2.9 ppl.

The **South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 122.3 ppl. The **North West** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 120.3 ppl. The **South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 125.1 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 122.8 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 118.4 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 3 ppl.
